Pick it up – Bag it up – Bin it

Time to remind dog walkers that dogs should be on leads on public footpaths. In Cosgrove this does apply to the Churchyard and the towpath - if you can't see your dog you can't pick up after it!

If you are aware enough to bag up what your dog leaves please put it in a bin or take it home - don't chuck the bag in the hedges! If a dog bin is full up please let a parish councillor know.

We do get problems with dog faeces in the fields - we have had farmers having to destroy cattle which have contracted disease from dog mess - even if it's biodegradable!
